How is Home Health Paid For?

Medicare, Medicaid and most private insurance pay for physician - ordered home health care services. Our staff will work with your insurance provider to help you understand the coverage available for your care. We work hard to help you recieve the care you need.

What is required to participate?

Medicare and many insurance companies require that patients meet homebound guidelines, which means that your medical condition makes it difficult for you to leave home, and when you do leave home it requires considerable effort. Being homebound does not mean you can never leave home. You may stil be considered homebound if your absences are infrequent or for short periods of time, and if those outing are taxing on your energy and comfort. The home health team can help make those determinations.

Our services are provided to patients who have a skilled need, which is defined as recurring nursing or therapy as the primary reason for care. That care is provided on an intermittent basis, with the professionals visiting periodically to support your independence.

Who can make a referral?

Anyone can ask about Home Health Services. It's best to plan ahead, and talk to your physician regarding your needs and arrange Home Health Services in advance. You have a choice when it comes to what agency you are referred to. Make sure you request Girard Medical Center's Home Health Agency.
