Patients Who Qualify for Home Health:

- Require skilled nursing or therapy
- Meet Medicare homebound status
- Need medically necessary, provider-ordered care
- Have a safe environment for home care

Patients Who **Do Not** Qualify:

- Need 24/7 supervision or custodial care only
- Are not homebound and can easily leave home
- Need long-term personal care without skilled services
- Can safely attend outpatient therapy

What Home Health Can Provide

- Skilled nursing assessments & wound care
- Therapy services (PT, OT)
- Medication teaching & disease management
- Safety evaluations & fall prevention
- Home Health Aide services (with skilled plan)

What Home Health Cannot Provide

- 24-hour care or supervision
- Housekeeping, errands, or transportation
- Daily aide-only care
- Emergency response services
